## 60 generous women

The Hospice Care Network was selected to receive \$6,000 from the new and growing organization 100 Women Who Care About Long Island.

At each of its quarterly meetings, 100 Women randomly selects three qualified charities, which are nominated by members in attendance. The three chosen mem-

bers are then given five minutes apiece to address the group about why their charity should be chosen for the quarterly donation.

At the group's second meeting, held last month, each of its 60 members donated \$100, bringing the tally for HCN to \$6,000. HCN provides care to terminally ill individuals and their families in Nassau, Suffolk and Queens.

The group's membership has grown since its inaugural meeting in July, when 37 members directed a \$3,700 prize to the Theresa Academy of Performing Arts in Lido Beach.

"We are truly astounded that the group has grown this quickly," said Laura Sikorski, media coordinator for 100 Women. "Our members are telling their business associates, friends and family."
